What are the Cariad Stones?

The Cariad Stones are a well-known rocky outcrop in Wales. They are associated with the phrase "Dduw Cariad Yw" and connect strongly with the meaning of the school name Cariad.

Rock Type

The Cariad Stones are most likely Pennant Sandstone — a hard sedimentary rock from South Wales. It formed from ancient river sands that were compacted and cemented over millions of years.

Why this matters for our learning

The symbolic meaning of Cariad Rock

- Love and care — Cariad means love
